How to Use: HOW TO USE:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. APPLY UNDILUTED.

Spray EcoSnail to give a good even coverage that leaves no gaps. Do not spray to run-off. It can be applied onto soil to protect plants and to tree trunks to prevent snails from entering the canopy. EcoSnail can be applied anytime but is best applied before or when snails and slugs are active. It is best applied when the surface is dry, except when applying to soil where it can be applied to damp soil. Allow to dry before watering. Avoid applying during rainfall.

Seedlings:

Spray the bare soil around plants and seedlings. Avoid spraying directly onto foliage.

Fruit trees, vine and berries:

Apply to trunks, stems and canes as a 30cm wide band.

Rockeries, fences, posts, pots, garden furniture, inside mailboxes and under ground

Spray to give a good even coverage, especially in dark and damp areas.
